VINEYARDS AND HARVEST NOTES

We selected grapes from the best vineyard plots, mainly from 30-year-old vines, using exclusively indigenous grape varieties of the highest quality: Touriga Franca, Touriga Nacional, Tinta Roriz, and others.

The 2022 viticultural year was exceptionally dry, with heat waves and rainfall well below average. The lack of water was the greatest challenge in the vineyards, although it ensured very good phytosanitary conditions. Harvest took place quite early. The vines reacted surprisingly well despite the adverse weather conditions. Vineyard management remained demanding, with close monitoring of vine development on a weekly basis—and at times daily—to harvest at the optimal moment. Phenolic ripeness was carefully controlled to achieve maximum aromatic potential.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

We use the most modern technology with full temperature control. The grape clusters were in perfect condition.

The grapes were vinified with total destemming followed by gentle crushing.

Alcoholic fermentation took place in a controlled environment at a temperature between 22°C and 24°C.

The wines were kept in stainless steel tanks.

TASTING NOTES

A 2022 Douro DOP red wine with a ruby color and fruity aromas, highlighting red berries.

An elegant and full-bodied wine.

The quality tannins and balanced acidity provide pleasant freshness and good persistence.

Enjoy on its own or paired with pasta, meats, and white or yellow cheeses.

Best served at 16°C.
